Dear Parents

This year's St. John's harvest celebration will be on Tuesday 30th September. It will consist of a Harvest Lunch followed by a Church Service. We are supporting the Crowborough and Rotherfield Churches Together Food bank and a list of food that they require is listed below. Please send any contributions of food (no fresh produce please!) with your child on the morning of 30th September. They take them into class and then each class is able to bring their contributions up to the school display. Some of these contributions will be taken to the church in the afternoon for the harvest service.

Unfortunately all the children and staff seem to fill the church but we would like to try inviting **RECEPTION parents only** to join us as a welcome to the celebrations we enjoy at church. Please note the only available space will be in the upstairs gallery at the back of the church.

As usual all the children will be participating in a special harvest lunch. Year 6 will be helping to prepare for harvest lunch and children in other years will be involved with making cakes or biscuits. The lunch will consist of a filled baguette, fruit, a carton of drink and cakes/biscuits. As Key Stage 1 pupils are included within the universal free school meals we are suggesting that they contribute 50p towards cooking ingredients. For Key stage 2 children the cost will be £2. These payments to cover the cost of lunch and cooking ingredients should be sent to the school office in a **named envelope** marked 'Harvest Lunch' by **Monday 29th September**. This is a family lunch which all children will be participating in. They will therefore not need to bring in a packed lunch on this day. If your child has a specific allergy or dietary requirement please provide details in writing and give them to your child's teacher.

Each class will need help with their cooking. If you are able to help any class with their harvest preparations on either the 29th or 30th September please speak to the class teacher **as soon as possible**.
